






# Crash Data Analysis


## Drivers By Age



**Older Drivers** - There is also a high percentage of drivers over the age of 50 in Hamilton crashes.

**New/Young Drivers** - When a driver's age is known, the drivers with the highest percent involvement in crashes are 15- to 19-year-olds, which is typical in Ravalli County and Montana city crashes.


## Vehicle by First Harmful Event



Note: the chart excludes collisions with another motor vehicle in order to show the variations in other collision types.


