

# CHSP and NHTSA

- One of many stakeholders invested in the CHSP
- NHTSA funding based on inclusion in the CHSP.
  - Must be one of the strategies in the CHSP

# NHTSA Funding

- SAFETEA-LU
  - Funding for specific traffic safety programs based on seat belt usage and alcohol related fatalities
- MAP-21
  - Requirements based on seat belt usage
  - Requirements based on alcohol related fatalities
  - Funding reductions
    - High Fatality Rate
    - Data
    - Motorcycle

*MDT must meet specific criteria to be eligible for NHTSA traffic safety funding.*

- \* Distracted Driver
- \* Graduated Drivers License

- Prevent and reduce impaired driving
- Continue improving data & traffic records systems

# New projects

- Competitive application process
- No continuation applications.
- Strategies must be part of the Comprehensive Safety Plan
- Locally developed performance measures
- Application due: **March 1, 2014**

# Timeline

- \* Application submission deadline for FFY 2015 funding. **March 1, 2014**
- \* Processing of applications
- \* Draft Annual Highway Safety Plan (HSP) prepared by MDT staff and submitted to the GR for approval.
- \* Deadline for Annual Highway Safety Plan submission to NHTSA. **July 1, 2014**
- \* Deadline for NHTSA to notify state whether or not FFY 2015 Highway Safety Plan is approved. **August 30, 2014**
- \* Notification to applicants regarding funding approval or denial. September, 2014
- \* Signed contracts due from grantees to MDT **October 1, 2014**

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## Grants and Funding

### Funding for Traffic Safety Projects

The Montana State Highway Traffic Safety Office administers federal grant monies for safety programs aimed at reducing deaths, injuries, and property losses resulting from traffic crashes.

Some of these grants cover administration costs such as increased overtime patrols for law enforcement agencies and the cost to purchase new law enforcement equipment. Others cover the production and delivery of educational programs.


